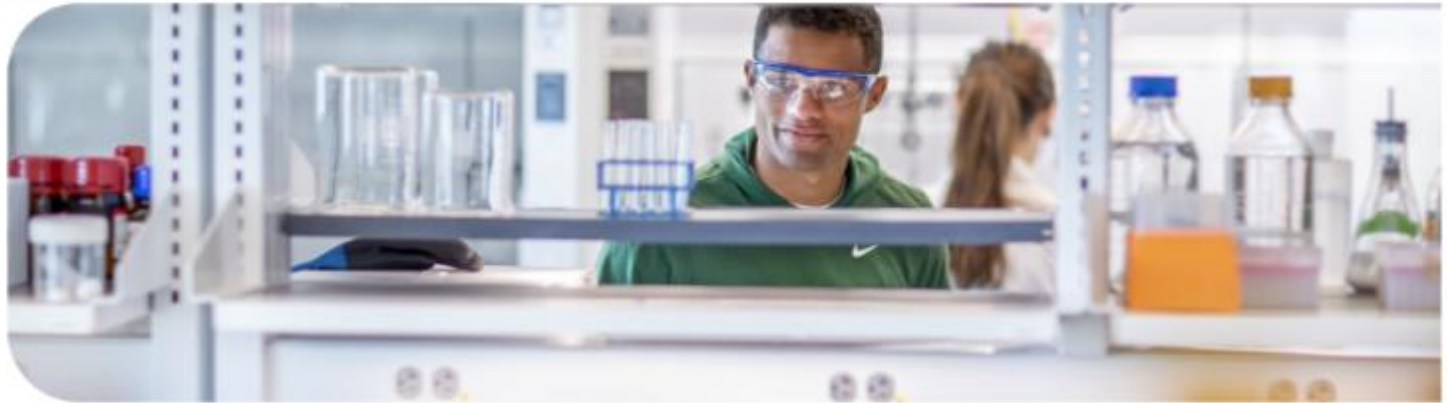

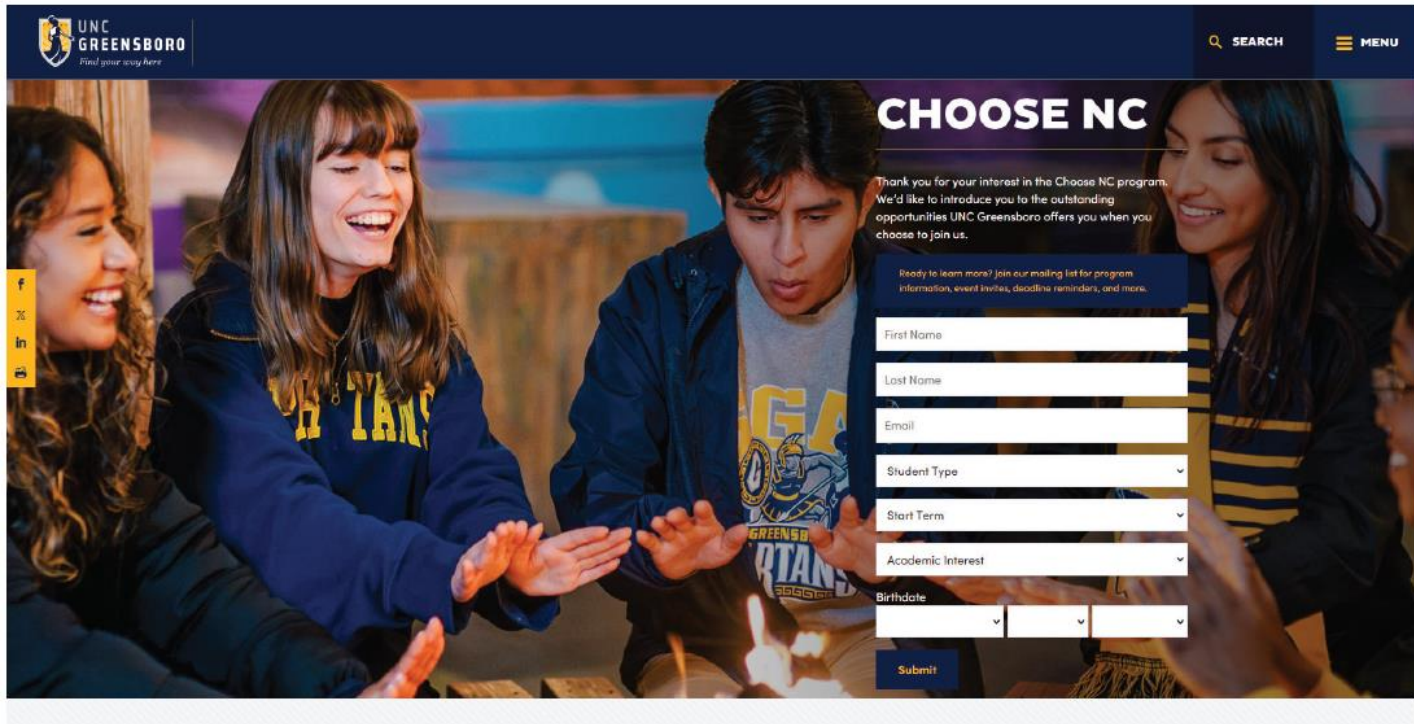

- The **Choose NC Program** allows students who are not admitted to UNC-Chapel Hill to automatically apply to other University of North Carolina System schools through the Common Application.
- It's fast, simple, and opens the door to more opportunities. We know the right school for students is out there, and this program is here to help them find it.

New Minimum Eligibility Requirements Students Entering in Fall 2025 or Spring 2026

High School GPA:

A minimum weighted GPA of 2.5.

Standardized Test Scores:

Students with a weighted High School GPA greater than or equal to 2.50 and less than 2.80 are required to submit a standardized test score (ACT or SAT).

NEW UPDATES

FOR STUDENTS ENTERING IN THE SPRING 2025 SEMESTER:

- ✔ A Minimum Weighted GPA of 2.5

OR

- ✔ A Composite ACT score of 19, or Combined SAT (Math and Reading) Score of 1010

FOR STUDENTS ENTERING IN THE FALL 2025 OR SPRING 2026 SEMESTERS:

- ✔ A Weighted GPA greater than or equal to 2.50 and less than 2.80
- ✔ A SAT/ACT Test Score

FALL 2026 SEMESTER & BEYOND

- ✔ Students with a Weighted GPA of 2.50-2.79 **will be required** to submit a 17 or higher on the ACT or a 930 or higher on the SAT.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

- ✔ Two additional academic courses from English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, World Languages, or Computer Science.
- ✔ Foreign Language Courses are no longer required for admission consideration, but are still encouraged.
